POWERING THE THRESHOLD

The THRESHOLD is an electro-pneumatic marker and requires the use of a 9-volt battery in order to operate the circuit board that controls the firing mechanism. Using fresh, high quality batteries will ensure optimal performance. The battery will slowly drain if left in the THRESHOLD - even if the marker is not on! To maximize battery life, remove the battery after you are done playing for the day. To insert a battery, you will need to take the supplied 3/32 hex key, unscrew the left grip panel, and remove it. Plug the battery into the harness and gently push it into place. The battery should fit snugly, but refrain from using force to coerce the wires into positions as doing so can cause serious damage!

Do not use CO₂ with the THRESHOLD marker. At high rates of fire with cold temperatures, liquid CO₂ can damage the solenoid. CO₂ is also much harsher on rubber o-rings and can cause irreparable damage within the regulators and other internals. Due to the THRESHOLD's use of an electronic solenoid and its capability for high rates of fire, only use nitrogen or compressed air.

The THRESHOLD operates at under 200 psi, and will perform equally well with either HP (high pressure) compressed air tanks. To attach a compressed air tank, simply insert it into the RAPS, and then flip the on/off switch shut. Be sure to lubricate the tank's o-ring from time to time to ensure that it does not dry out and become susceptible to leaking. Avoid using any kind of oil in the RAPS, as liquids can damage the solenoid.

To disconnect the air tank, first make sure that there are no paintballs in the marker. Flip the on/off switch on the front of the RAPS. The THRESHOLD's HPR (High Pressure Regulator) can still hold air, even after the tank is deactivated. Clear the remaining air out of the THRESHOLD by dry firing until it no longer fires. Once completed, unscrew air tank. Do not fasten air tank on the THRESHOLD unless you intend to fire it. Promptly remove after use to prevent accidental discharge.

ADJUSTING PRESSURE AND VELOCITY

When air enters the THRESHOLD, it first enters through the HPR where it is regulated down to approximately 150~200 psi. From there, the air takes two paths - the first path leads to the chamber and allows the bolt to propel the paintball. The second path leads air flows through the solenoid and is responsible for cycling the bolt back to open the valve. The majority of the paintball's velocity is a function of the HPR.





KEY HIGHLIGHTS:

- Before attaching the air system, ensure the air system adapter is in place.
- The initial adjustment should be made with no paintballs loaded.
- When adjusting or operating with low pressure, always check the velocity using chronograph devices.
- Use caution when adjusting, as internal damage may occur to the components or the regulator systems and may void the warranty.

HPR ADJUSTMENT

- The HPR is adjustable by using the hex screw at the bottom (use HEX tool 1/4).
- Turning the adjustment screw clockwise, or in, will lower the HPR's output pressure. Turning the adjustment screw counterclockwise, or out, will raise the HPR's output pressure.
- The THRESHOLD marker operates with greatest efficiency with the HPR gauge at approximately 180 psi.
- The suggested operating pressure is between 150 to 200 psi. Exceeding 200 psi with the HPR is not necessary to reach the 300 fps universal velocity limit. Increasing pressure beyond what is recommended can damage part (#5) as well as create other problems.
- Immediately shut off HPR if any leakage is detected.

TRIGGER ADJUSTMENT

- The two adjustment screws are located on the trigger and trigger guard (use HEX tool 5/64).
- The top screw controls the over-travel. By turning this screw you can adjust how far the trigger will travel after it reaches the firing point.
- The bottom screw below controls the forward travel. Screwing it in will shorten the trigger's length of pull.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

It is possible to adjust the trigger to the point where it is past the activation point, or not capable of being activated. Both conditions may lead user to believe the marker is inoperable.





LED INTERFACE OPERATION

Before operating the PC board of THRESHOLD, ensure the barrel blocking device is in place. There is an operating button located on the back. Follow activation instructions for how to read the LED interface:

ACTIVATION

- 1. To activate THRESHOLD, hold down button "A" for 1.5 seconds. When the red light turns into a blinking blue light, the sensor has been activated.
- 2. THRESHOLD is ready to be fired once the marker has been loaded and the blue light remains on.
- 3. Press the button "A" to switch sensor systems.
- 4. THRESHOLD will turn off automatically after 20 minutes of non-use.
- 5. Press "A" to manually shut off THRESHOLD.

- 7. Solenoid dwell adjustment (for advanced users only)
- Dip 5 OFF 6 OFF 12ms
- Dip 5 ON 6 OFF 14ms (recommended)
- Dip 5 OFF 6 ON 16ms

- 8. ABS (Anti Bolt Stick) default
- Dwell is programmed at 16ms upon first shot.
- Thereafter,dwell is programmed at 14ms, unless adjusted.
- Dwell will return into 16ms after 50 seconds of non-use.

DEACTIVATION

- Press and hold the power button "A" for 4 seconds.
- Release the button once the LED light shuts off.

BOARD ADJUSTMENT

Using a HEX tool, remove the two screws located on the top and bottom of grip with the THRESHOLD pointing to the left. The two adjusting finger switches are located on the top of the PC board.

EXTERNAL MAINTENANCE

Most contaminates found on external surfaces can easily be removed with water or a few drops of cleaning oil and a dry clean, dry cloth. Other useful supplies for maintaining THRESHOLD are clean rags, Q-tips, and water / rubbing alcohol mix.






SENSOR SYSTEM MAINTENANCE

The sensor system must be kept clean for optimal performance. Please follow the instructions below for cleaning and maintenance:

- 1. Remove the two screws located on the top and bottom of grip using a HEX tool 5/64.
- 2. Clean the area thoroughly with cotton swab.
- 3. Replace the sensor system and the cover.
- 4. Replace the screws back onto the sensor system cover.

BOLT MAINTENANCE




THRESHOLD is equipped with a Delrin fieldstrip bolt for durability and reducing friction. The bolt must be kept clean for optimal performance. If the surface of the bolt becomes sticky, please use the following cleaning instructions:


- 1. Make sure the air system is not attached to THRESHOLD and there is no paintball inside.
- 2. Take out the bolt cap and remove the bolt cap from the rear (use HEX tool 3/16).





- 3. Take out the bolt and remove the bolt from the rear.
- 4. Clean the bolt with a clean cloth, and take out all o-rings from the bolt. Replace any worn o-rings.
- 5. After completing above instructions, lubricate the o-ring with Dow-55 lubricant.
- 6. Replace the bolt and bolt cap and lock using the HEX tool.










- Disconnect the macro-line.
- 2. Unscrew the bottom portion of the regulator.
- 3. Screw the adjustment screw all the way in.
- 4. Gently tap top end down until the piston (part #42) is free from the HPR body.
- 5. Take care to note the order of shims.
- 6. Clean the piston and examine the two o-rings for any visible signs of damage. Replace if necessary.
- 7. Once cleaned/replaced, lubricate the o-rings with Dow-55 lubricant.
- 8. Replace shims in same order on the piston, and reinsert into HPR body.
- 9. Screw body onto the top portion of the HPR and reinsert macro-line.

STORAGE AND TRANSPORTATION

- Clean and deactivate THRESHOLD. Detach air systems when not in use.
- Make sure the barrel blocking device is in place when not in use.
- Keep THRESHOLD away from any unauthorized users.
- During transportation, THRESHOLD must be detached from air sources.
- Do not carry THRESHOLD uncased when not on a playing field. Non-playing public and law enforcement personnel may mistake the marker for a firearm.
- Always carry THRESHOLD in its factory case or a suitable marker case.
- Never transport charged N2 / compressed air or CO2 air systems.








